





# GET OUT THE VOTE (GOTV)


In order to educate Muslims about the civic process and recruit volunteers for local GOTV efforts, volunteers assisted as mosque captains, at voter registrations, and as election officers






# 2016 MUSLIM VOTER TURNOUT

Utilized Emgage Action to raise
money for his opponent and distributed our voter card.

 Mobilized 2,500 voters in a swing district with a 90% turnout.

   as she continues to fight for her constituents after her win.




