Have you ever gone to vote in November and thought, how come these candidates are my choices? Primary elections are elections held by political parties to select each party's nominees for elected offices. The outcome of the Primary elections determines which candidates will appear on the ballot for the November General election for federal, state, and local offices.

<ul> <li>To vote in New York State you must be: <ul> <li>A U.S. Citizen</li> <li>18 years old (you may pre-register at 16 or 17 but cannot vote until 18)</li> <li>A resident of New York State and the county, city or village for at least 30 days before the election.</li> </ul> </li> <li>You cannot vote in New York State if: <ul> <li>You are currently in prison for a felony conviction</li> <li>You claim the right to vote anywhere else.</li> </ul> </li> <li>*Although not always required, it is best practice to always bring your photo ID.</li> </ul> To check if you are already registered to vote, visit <a href="https://voterlookup.elections.ny.gov/">https://voterlookup.elections.ny.gov/</a>		<ul> <li>your poll site for assistance.</li> <li>4. Can I vote in the democratic primary if I am not a registered Democrat?</li> <li>• NO. New York has a closed primary. You can only as a party member for the party you are registered under. For example, you must be a registered Democrat to vote in the Democratic primary.</li> <li>5. Will my ballot be disqualified if I do not fill in a response.</li> </ul>
